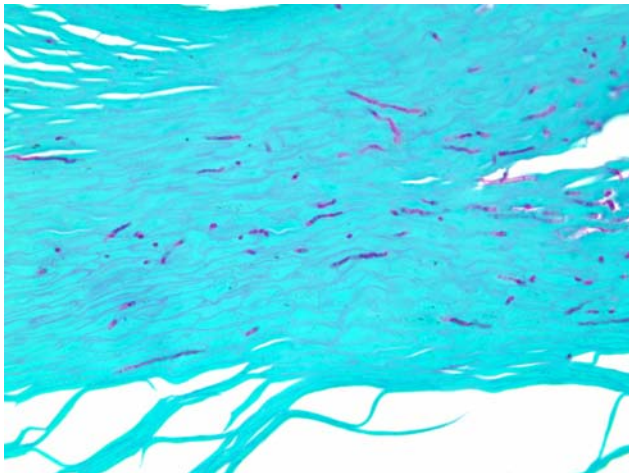

GROSS DESCRIPTION:

A. The specimen is received in formalin labeled "nails" and consists of six dark brown apparent nail fragments ranging in size from 0.4 x 0.2 cm to 0.7 x 0.4 cm. The specimen is submitted in toto and placed in KOH before being processed on the "derm cycle".

MICROSCOPIC DESCRIPTION:

A. NAIL CLIPPINGS: Sections are of dystrophic nail plate material. PAS stain reveals hyphal elements within the keratotic material with appropriate control testing.



PAS Stain
